1. Welcome to Lincolnshire Athletics County Championship 2026

A warm welcome is extended to all athletes and spectators.

2. Eligibility to Compete

Athletes are eligible either by virtue of birth or residence in Lincolnshire. Some athletes will have a dual qualification i.e. born in one County living in the other – these athletes must choose which County they wish to compete in, or for. They must stay with the same county each calendar year so if they entered Cross Country Championships of either County in 2025/2026 XC season they have made their choice for this year.

3. Age Groups

U10 - at least 8 or 9 years old on 31st August. 2026

U12 - at least 10 or 11 years old on 31st August. 2026

U14 - 12 or 13 years old on 31st August. 2026

U16 - 14 or 15 years old on 31st August. 2026

U18 - 16 or 17 years old on 31st August. 2026

U20 - 18 or 19 years old on 31st December 2026

Seniors are 20 and over on 31st December 2026

Masters will be in the age groups below on the day of competition:

4. Awards

The first three competitors in each event and age group will be awarded county badges.

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6. Data Protection

7. Starting heights and Number of trials

Opening heights

U14 Girls HJ will open at 1.00m - the bar rising in 5cm increments.

U14 Boys HJ at 1.10m - the bar rising in 5cm increments.

PV will start at 1.70m rising in 10cm increments.

Throws and horizontal jumps will be a 'straight 4 attempts'

U12 Long Jump will be 3 Jumps Only.

Athletes may use their own implements if the equipment has been presented to the Field Referee for weighing at least 1 hour prior to the event in which the equipment shall be used. Athletes may use their own Starting blocks (needs approval by Starter's assistant).

8. U10 & U12 – Multi-events

For the first time ever in the county champs U10s and U12s are offered a multi-event (Funetics type) competition consisting of 3 events. These will take place on Sunday and will start at 9am and will hopefully finish before the main programme starts at 10:30am. Athletes will need to register and collect numbers by 8:45am.

9. UKA Anti-Doping Rules:

UKA Anti-Doping Rules

Athletes are required to read this statement from UKA

'An entrant shall be deemed to have made him/herself/their self, familiar with, and agreed to be bound by the UKA Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules. The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the date of entry, whether the licence holder is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.'

Entering the County Championships will be taken as acceptance of the above statement.

10. Closing date:

The closing date is 19/4/2026 (midnight). No late entries accepted.

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11. Entry Fees:

Meeting Fee = £5

U10 and U12 multi-event = Meeting fee plus £8
i.e. £5+£8 = £13

U16 and Under - Meeting fee plus £4 per event
i.e. 1 event is £5+£4 = £9

U18 and older – Meeting fee plus £5 per event
i.e. 1 event is £5+£5 = £10

Please note the number of events an athlete in each age group may compete in is as below.

UKA rules to be applied

U12s, U14s, U16s and U18s can only do 3 events per day

U14s can only compete in one event between 600m and 1 mile

U16s can only compete in one event between 600m and 3000m

Athletes may enter and pay for as many events as they choose but will be limited on the day to the number of events they are allowed to compete in for their age group.

*** The organisers reserve the right to cancel events where there are insufficient entries or for other logistical reason – a full refund or transfer to another event will be offered. ***

We are unable to issue refunds under any other circumstances.
